Melbourne Water works closely with the community and other agencies to manage the impact of deer and other wild animals on our protected water supply catchments and high-value waterways. We will be conducting further deer management programs within Silvan Reservoir during 2023.

Melbourne Water's deer management program includes both regular monitoring and, where required, control activities. Currently, deer numbers within the Silvan Reservoir closed catchment area are at levels that have the potential to impact water quality, river health values and the health of indigenous plants and animals. Failure to actively manage the deer population could also have negative impacts on the health and welfare of the deer as they compete for limited food resources within the catchment. Therefore, we are planning to do further deer management operations during 2023 in the closed catchment area.

What does the deer management program involve?

Melbourne Water has explored all options and concluded that relocating deer is not a feasible form of population control, nor is a sterilisation program. Therefore a deer cull will be carried or by accredited and authorised contractors. We will observe the highest standards and the culling will be done in accordance with the prevention of cruelty to animals legislation.


What are the potential impacts on the community?

The Silvan Reservoir boundary will be patrolled for the duration of the operation. Disturbances such as vehicle movements and noise will be kept to a minimum.


