## WORKING BEE

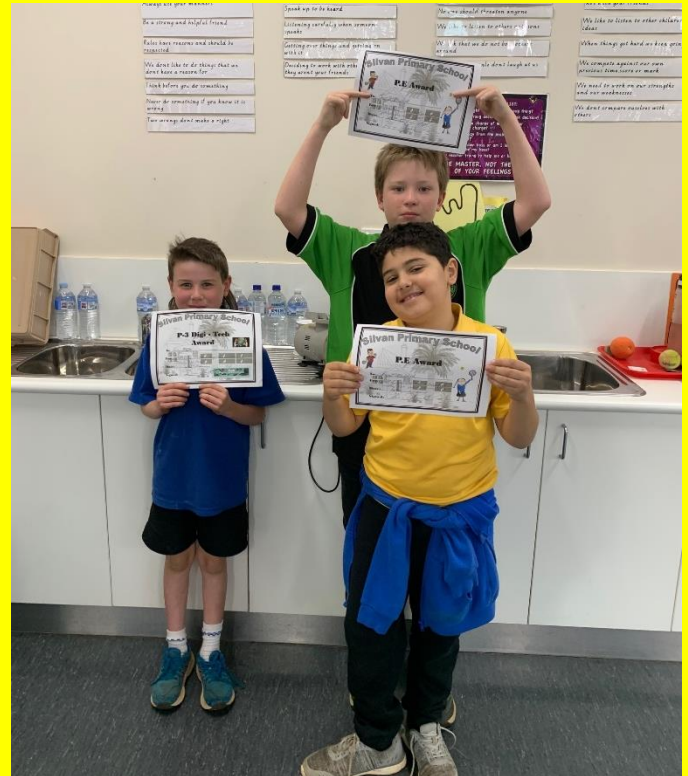

## ROTATIONS

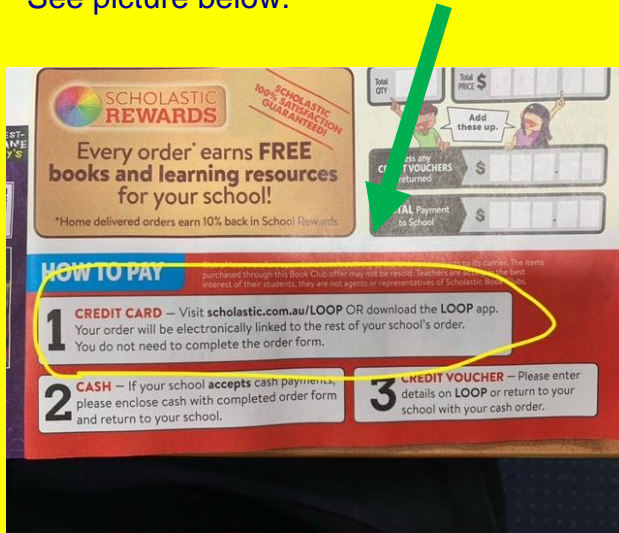
